It is pertinent to mention here that Vidyarthi Vigyan Manthan (VVM) is a unique digital application based talent search examination that is conducted online at the national level. The registered students will be allowed to take the examination from his/her school or a specified centre through his/her own device, namely, a smart phone (mobile), laptop, desktop (school lab) or tablet. Examination will not be conducted on any of the Apple Devices.

The school level examination can be answered on any one of the specified date (either on a working or a non-working day) as opted by the 'School Examination Coordinator'. 
