

Dear Students/Teachers/Parents/State Coordinators,

Please note the following common instructions/points...

1. Please ensure you have filled all the required details along with your itinerary in excel spreadsheet shared with you. Request to provide any help without prior intimation will not be accepted.
2. Photography/Videography of office buildings inside Anushaktinagar area is strictly prohibited.
3. Please do not make any argument with security. No compromise on security related issues. Keep your photo identity proof such as Aadhar Card, Voter ID Card, Driving License, and Passport in original and valid Student School Id Card handy all the time in campus.
4. Mumbai's weather will be quite hot during the national camp. So keep the water bottles with you.
5. Students and State Coordinators stay arrangements have been made in the Hostel/s in Anushaktinagar Campus. No facilities will be provided to parents/relatives of students. Our volunteers will be there to assist you. **Girl students will be accommodated in separate Ladies wing of the hostel.**
6. **Please bring your personal toiletry kit for your use during your stay at hostel like toothbrush, toothpaste, comb, soap, towel etc.**
7. No Travel Allowance will be given to attend the National Level Camp. State Level Winners (Top 2 rankers) will have to attend the National Camp with their own travel expenses.
8. Bring your passport size latest color photograph and submit at the time of registration with your name on the back of the photograph (students only).
9. You are requested to keep the photocopy/original of State Level Merit certificate with you as you will have to produce the same at the time of registration.
10. **Parents/Escort Teachers/Guests are invited for Inaugural and Valedictory function, which will be held at DAE Convention Centre. However, they are not allowed at the exam venue, located nearby.**
11. **Talks on interesting topics have been arranged for Parents/Escort Teachers/Guests during the time of the camp. We are sure they will enjoy the same.**
12. Don't bring any valuables as locker facility will not be available.
13. Any electronic gadgets including mobile phones and calculators will not be allowed at the exam center.

14. Schedule of the camp will be in the registration kit.
15. No pick-up and drop facility will be provided, please use public/appropriate transport to reach the venue.
16. Reporting time for the examination is 08:00AM, on 12 May 2018, delay in the reporting will lead to disqualifications. Reporting place will be notified soon.
17. On time reporting / drop and pickup at/from venue of the students staying with their guardians, escort teachers will be their sole responsibility.
18. Local Transport Details:

While entering in Anushaktinagar premises you will have to enter from 'Main Gate' only and you need to get Security Clearance (Gate Pass) for your vehicle/auto/taxi etc.

The following guidelines will help you reach the Centre either by road or by suburban (local) train from the main entry points of the city.

A. From the Chhatrapati Shivaji International Airport (Sahar) and Chhatrapati Shivaji Domestic Airports (Santacruz)

You may take a pre-paid taxi to Anushakti Nagar. The approximate distance is 20 km and the fare is about Rs. 400/-. It is always advisable to take a pre-paid taxi from the Domestic/ International Airport.

B. From Railway Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Terminal (CSMT/VT)

If you alight at Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Terminus (CSMT) formally known as Victoria Terminus (VT), buy a suburban train ticket (1st class or 2nd class) to Mankhurd railway station and board the suburban train (Central Railway Harbor Line) marked M, VA, BR, KD or PL. The journey time is approximately 55 minutes. Order of suburban stations on the route are Mumbai CST, Masjid bundar, Sandhurst Road, Dockyard Road, Reay Road, Cotton green, Sewri, Wadala Road, GTB Nagar, Chunabhatti, Kurla, Tilak Nagar, Chembur, Govandi and Mankhurd.

Alight at the Mankhurd railway station and come out of the station on the east side (Platform No. 2 side).

Take an auto-rickshaw (three-wheeler) to Anushaktinagar Main Gate. [\(Approximately 1 km from Mankhurd railway station\)](#)

C. From Railway Dadar Terminal

If you alight at Dadar Terminus/local station (both are adjacent to each other)

You may directly take a taxi to Anushakti Nagar. The taxi fare will be about Rs.250/-. It is not advisable to take the suburban train from Dadar (Central Railway Main Line) in the evening after 3pm, especially on a working day.

If you still wish to come by the suburban train (Central Railway Main Line), buy a ticket to Mankhurd railway station. This is a direct ticket and will be valid for the journey upto Mankhurd Railway station.

Take a suburban train (Fast or Slow) which goes either upto Kurla station or passes through Kurla Station, and get down at Kurla station. Order of suburban stations on the route are Matunga, Sion and Kurla.

Take the Foot over bridge then change over to Harbor line train on platform number 7 to take another suburban train (Central Railway) Harbor Line. Order of suburban stations on the route are Tilak Nagar, Chembur, Govandi and Mankhurd.

Alight at Mankhurd railway station and come out of the station on the east side (Platform No. 2 side).

Follow steps (2. c to 2. e) to reach destination.

D. From Lokmanya Tilak (Kurla) Railway Terminus (Central Railway)

If you alight at Kurla Terminus, you may take an auto-rickshaw (three-wheeler) to Anushakti Nagar. Auto fare will be about Rs. 100/-.

If you wish to come by the local train buy a ticket to Mankhurd and board suburban train (Central Railway Harbor Line) from Tilak Nagar suburban station. Order of suburban stations on the route are Chembur, Govandi and Mankhurd.

After alighting at the Mankhurd station, come out of the station on the east side (Platform No. 2 side).

Follow steps (2. c to 2. e) to reach your destination.

E. From Railway Terminal Mumbai Central (Western Railway)

If you alight at Mumbai Central /local station (both are adjacent to each other)

You may directly take a taxi to Anushakti Nagar. The taxi fare will be about Rs. 450/-. It is not advisable to take the suburban train from Mumbai Central (Western Railway) in the evening after 3pm, especially on a working day.

If you wish to come by the suburban train (Western Railway), buy a ticket to Mankhurd railway station. This is a direct ticket and will be valid for the journey upto Mankhurd Railway station.

Take a suburban train (Fast or Slow) which goes either upto Dadar station or passes through Dadar Station, and get down at Dadar station. Order of suburban stations on the route are Mahalaxmi, Lower Parel, Elphinstone Road and Dadar (West). Take the Foot over bridge (towards East side) then change over to Dadar (Central Railway).

Follow steps (3. d to 3. g) to reach destination

F. From Railway Terminal Bandra (Western Railway)

You may directly take a taxi to Anushakti Nagar. The taxi fare will be about Rs. 300/-. It is not advisable to take the suburban train from Bandra (Western Railway). A cheaper option would be to take an auto-rickshaw to Anushakti Nagar / BARC. Auto fare from Bandra Terminal will be about Rs. 150/-.

Another option is traveling by bus (BEST buses) from Bandra Bus stand Route number 371 directly to Anushakti Nagar Bus depot.

Walk towards west side (2-3 Minutes) and you will see the Anushakti Nagar Main Gate.

G. From Railway Chhatrapati Shivaji Terminal (CST/VT) (Via Express Free Way)

Alight at Harbor side (platform No. 18 side) of Chhatrapati Shivaji Terminus (CST) formally known as Victoria Terminus (VT) and take a taxi to Anushakti Nagar. The taxi fare will be about Rs. 400/-. It is about 20 Km drive and will take about 25-35 minutes.

Note for visitors, travelling from the major Railway Stations: You may keep in mind the following order of proximity from the Anushakti Nagar while alighting: Kurla terminus, Dadar terminus, Mumbai Central and CST (Chhatrapati Shivaji Terminus or VT for Victoria Terminus), farthest being CST.
