
VVM-National Talent Search Examination is an initiative of Vigyan Bharati in collaboration with Vigyan Prasar,DST, Govt. of India and NCERT. It is a programme aimed at popularizing Science among students of class VI to XI conceptualized to identify bright minds with a Scientific aptitude from the students community. VVM exam is conducted through online open book examination through online mode on VVM website [www.vvm.org.in](http://www.vvm.org.in).

This year VVM 2022-23 again will be online open-book science talent search examination using digital devices. Participating students can appear for the exam by using their own device like Smartphone, Laptop/Desktop etc. from their school.The examination will be conducted separately for junior group (class 6-8) and for senior group (class 9-11). The winners at School level, District level, and State level will be given participation certificate/merit certificate. The Top three National winners will be given memento and cash prize too.

Moreover, this year VVM is coming up with Bhaskara Scholarship for Himalayans (18 students) and SRIJAN (Internship-cum-extensive Training Program) for all national level winners (90 students). It will be continued with Mega Nation-Wide experiment this year as well. It is an experiment based on the food habits of students, the nutritional value of the consumed food, and its environmental impact. The objectives of this mega experiment are to teach observational skill, a scientific mindset, and analytical thinking among students.

Kindly ensure participation of maximum 5 students from class(VI to XI) in VVM 2022-23. The fee of Rs.170/- per child may be paid from VVN. Science teachers may be instructed to give guidance for VVM and encourage the students to participate and perform well. JNVs may appoint a coordinator teacher for coordinating VVM activities. The participating students will be registered at school level. The last date of registration is 25-10-2022. VVM brochure 2022-23 is attached for ready reference.
