**Sub: Regarding Vidyarthi Vigyan Manthan 2021-22: India's Largest Science Talent Search for New India using Digital Devices.**

Madam/Sir,

I am to refer letter no VP/058 /85/VVM/21/29, dated 07-09-2021 (**copy enclosed**) from the Scientist F, Vigyan Prasar (An Autonomous Organisation under the Dept. of Science & Technology, Govt. of India) on the subject cited above and to inform that Vigyan Prasar (VP), in association with National Council of Education Research and Training (NCERT) and Vijnana Bharati, is conducting the 10th Vidyarthi Vigyan Manthan (VVM) 2021-22 for school students for classes VI to XI on **30<sup>th</sup> November 2021 and 5<sup>th</sup> December 2021**.

VVM 2021-22 will be India's first open-book science talent search examination to be held in 12 Indian languages and designed to be carried out using digital devices (App based). This 90 minute examination can be attempted by the students on any of the exam dates between 10:00 am to 8:00 pm from the comfort of their home and following all COVID norms.

Moreover, this year VVM is coming up with Mega Nation-wide Experiment based on the food habits of students, the nutritional value of the consumed food, and its environmental impact will continue this year as well.

- Learning through Hands on Activities
