 - First Slide: Students should mention the theme and the specific topic which they have chosen. Also, they have to mention Student Id, their Class and Name of the State or Union Territory to which they belong to.
 - > Second Slide: Introduction should include description of Origin/History of the selected topic.
 - **Third Slide:** Importance, relevance and characteristic features should be given.
 - Fourth Slide: Present status and the efforts made for conservation or promotion should be described.

Note: On slide No. 2 to 4 the source of information should be mentioned in one line at the bottom of the slide.
