 - > Second Slide: Introduction should include description of Origin/History of the selected topic.
 - ➤ Third Slide: Importance, relevance and characteristic features should be given.
 - Fourth Slide: Present status and the efforts made for conservation or promotion should be described.

Note: On slide No. 2 to 4 the source of information should be mentioned in one line at the bottom of the slide.
