<u>CREATIVITY ACTIVITY</u> JUNIOR GROUP (CLASS VI, VII & VIII)

Environmental issues can be defined as the harmful effects of human activities on the earth's environment. Environmental issues include many types of human activities which cause pollution, waste disposal, climate change, global warming, the greenhouse effect, etc. Students will be given any topic of environmental issues and asked to make a Mind-Map in the stipulated time.

Instructions to the students:

- 1. Read and understand about the above-suggested themes in advance.
- 2. Each student must make a mind map on the topic she/he gets.
- 3. The mind map should contain information about
 - i) The problem stated
 - ii) Steps being taken to overcome the problem by the world
 - iii) Steps being taken by India in order to overcome the problem
 - iv) How can you contribute in this?
- 4. Each student would get 30 minutes to finish the activity as well as answer the questions posed by the evaluators.
- 5. The students will be provided with Chart paper and a few other items in case it is required.

Students are expected to carry:

- 1) Geometry box
- 2) Color pencils
- 3) Crayons
- 4) Sketch pens
- 5) Anything else they may need for making the mind-map/concept map

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CREATIVITY ACTIVITY SENIOR GROUP (CLASS IX, X & XI)

The Y20 is aimed at enabling young people to express their visions and ideas to the Heads of State and Government of the G20. It is an inclusive discussion platform, from which a series of agreed recommendations related to the G20 agenda are compiled into a joint communiqué.

This year's Y20 Summit will take place in August 2023, in Varanasi, India, and the official organizing entity is Y20 India. The Y20 India Summit in 2023 would be a valuable opportunity for the global youth to reflect on the five main areas and suggest policy recommendations for consultations with the G20 member states. The five main themes of 2023 Y20 are:



- 1) Future of Work: Industry 4.0, Innovation & 21st Century Skills
- 2) Climate Change and Disaster Risk Reduction: Making Sustainability a Way of Life
- 3) Shared Future: Youth in Democracy and Governance
- 4) Peace building and Reconciliation: Ushering in an Era of No War
- 5) Health, Wellbeing, and Sports: Agenda for Youth

Out of these, we have chosen the following four themes for the students -

- i) Climate Change and Disaster Risk Reduction: Making Sustainability a Way of Life
- ii) Shared Future: Youth in Democracy and Governance
- iii)Peace building and Reconciliation: Ushering in an Era of No War
- iv) Health, Wellbeing, and Sports: Agenda for Youth

Instructions to the students:

- 1. Read and understand about the theme suggested above in advance.
- 2. Find out what steps have been taken or are being taken by India to achieve these themes.
- 3. What are or can be your contribution/suggestions towards achieving these themes?
- 4. Each student must make a mind map on the topic she/he gets. She/he will be evaluated on following points -

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- a) Clear information about the topic given
- b) How is the youth affected by this and can benefit?
- c) How can the youth of India contribute towards this?
- d) How can you contribute towards this?
- 5. Each student would get 30 minutes to finish the activity as well as answer the questions posed by the evaluators.
- 6. The students will be provided with Chart paper and a few other items in case it is required.

Students are expected to carry:

- 1) Geometry box
